1. ALL coaches, umpires and WP Parks & Recreation Board Members are volunteers. We welcome any team parent volunteers to help coaches get children ready for games and/or provide snacks and drinks for after games. Ask your coach how you can help. We all play a major role in ensuring our children have fun playing sports.
2. Please have your child to practice 15 minutes early. You are expected to have your child picked up by the end of the practice and/or game. If your child is not able to make it or will be late, please call your coach and let him/her know.
3. Be positive and encourage your child. There is no "I" in team. We are all winners no matter what the score is. Cheer on each team in a positive manner.
4. No offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures to coaches, referees or players by parents, family members or your child. If this happens, you will be asked to leave the sport and WILL NOT be able to return. This is your one and ONLY warning, we have had problems at previous sporting events and it's time for it to stop! Remember, this is for the kids! Please pass this information onto family members that may attend games.
5. If there is a complaint, do not address it at games or practices. Call Sherry Gipson @ 483-8189 or Jenny Hagner @ 651-6545, they will take care of it.
6. Remember umpires do the best they can. They cannot see everything and this is not Major League Baseball... the children are here to have fun! Please respect the decisions they make.
7. Parents... we are NOT a babysitting service. The only children allowed at the fields are the players. All other children must be accompanied by a parent.
8. Since this is an outdoor sport we are asking at least 1 parent to remain at the fields during practices and games. We need a parent handy in case of an injury or bad weather. We never know what the weather is going to do.
9. No one is allowed on the field at any time during the games.
10. Please make sure your child goes to the bathroom before coming to the field and send your child to practice with a water bottle. There may not be a working fountain or restroom at the field.
11. Game shirts must be visible at all times. Please dress your child appropriately. Game shirts can be worn over a jacket or sweatshirt on chilly days.
12. Please be positive and proud to be a parent of a "Chief".
