

CO-ED TENNIS CAMP PARENT CONTRACT



1. ALL instructors and WP Parks and Recreation Board Members are volunteers. We welcome any parent volunteers to help the instructor get children ready for play. We also need sideline parents to help keep children occupied and play games with them while they are waiting their turn at the net. Please offer your assistance and ask the instructor how you can help. We all play a major role in ensuring our children have fun playing sports.
2. Please have your child to camp 15 minutes early. You are expected to have your child picked up by the end of the session.
3. Please explain to your child not to bang the rackets on the ground and that tennis rackets are not to be swung at others... tennis rackets are also not swords. If your child is caught using his/her tennis racket in an unsafe manner... 1st offense he/she will run a lap, 2nd offense he/she will run a lap and will not be able to get the racket back. This is a real safety issue.
4. No offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures to instructors or players, by parents, family members, or your child. If this happens, you will be asked to leave the sport and WILL NOT be able to return.
5. If there is a complaint, do not address it at camp. Call Jenny Hagner (Tennis Director) at 651-6545, she will take care of it.
6. Parents... we are NOT a babysitting service. The only children allowed at the courts are the players. All other children must be accompanied by a parent.
7. Please make sure your child goes to the bathroom before coming to the court. There is no bathroom at the courts.
8. Please send your child to camp with a water bottle and a sweat towel.
9. Since this is an outdoor sport we are asking at least 1 parent to remain at the courts during camp. We need a parent handy in case of an injury or bad weather. A parent also needs to be handy in case your child needs to go to the bathroom. The instructor will not be able to walk children to the gas station for potty breaks.
10. Tennis camp shirts must be visible at all times. Please dress your child appropriately for the weather.
11. Please be positive and proud to be a parent of a "Chief".

I have read the above list of rules, I will agree to follow them as well as remind my child to follow these rules, and the rules set forth by the instructor.
